



## Student Competition

CSCE Saskatoon welcomes all students to construct a popsicle stick bridge and compete in our annual Popsicle Stick Bridge Competition!

**DATE:** Thursday, January 26<sup>th</sup>, 2017

**TIME:** 3:30 pm – 5:00 pm

**LOCATION:** Structures Lab, Room 1C01, Engineering Building, University of Saskatchewan

**TEAMS:** Teams consist of 1 to 4 students

**ENTRANCE FEE:** **Free!**

**PRIZES:** 1<sup>st</sup> and 2<sup>nd</sup> place winners will be chosen based on the teams that score the most points in the competition (see bridge specifications and contest rules for full details). Prizes are as follows:

1<sup>st</sup> Place – \$120

2<sup>nd</sup> Place – \$80

Student winners will be recognized at Professionals' Night (which follows the Popsicle Stick Bridge Competition).

*Please note:* Only bridge entries constructed by undergraduate students will be eligible for the monetary prizes. Graduate students are still more than welcome to enter the contest at no charge!

**MATERIALS:** The bridge must be constructed from a maximum of 100 popsicle sticks and a 120 mL bottle of white glue.

Building material kits are provided (at no cost) by the CSCE Saskatoon Section, and are available from the Civil & Geological Engineering Department Office (Room 3B48). Teams are also allowed to purchase their own building supplies, provided they use only the allowed materials listed above.
